S-2 GRANT PROGRAM AND GLENSIDE BOULEVARD PHASE III

Mike Berrevoets from Fishbeck Thompson Carr & Huber, Inc. reviewed with Council the phased construction plan for Glenside Boulevard including the extent of the Glenside Storm Sewer District. Much of the central area of the City can eventually be served by the Glenside storm sewer that was installed as part of the first two phases. A tentative schedule for Glenside Phase III was also presented.

The new S-2 program allows for grants of up to \$1 million covering 90% of the cost incurred in completing applications for State Revolving Fund (SRF) construction funds. The S-2 funding package was approved in the lame duck session of the Michigan legislature and has been signed by the Governor. Jim Smalligan from Fishbeck Thompson Carr and Huber reviewed the S-2 program and how it may benefit the City of Roosevelt Park.
