2009-021 **CONSENT AGENDA**

2009-022 **ARC/MUSKEGON WALK – MARCH 28, 2009**

The mission of Arc/Muskegon is to assure that citizens of Muskegon County with cognitive and developmental disabilities and their families have an equal opportunity to participate in, and contribute to the quality of life in their community. March is Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month and the Awareness Walk, which has been held for the past twelve years, acknowledges developmental disabilities. The money raised from this event stays within Muskegon County and is used to provide awareness, programs and services for people with developmental disabilities and their families.

Arc/Muskegon is again requesting to hold their annual 5K walk/run in Roosevelt Park, beginning and ending at the Community Center. The event will be scheduled for Saturday, March 28, 2009 from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon. Margaret O’Toole, Executive Director of Arc/Muskegon has indicated that they expect between 50 to 100 participants. The walk will take place on City sidewalks:

- beginning at the Community Center
- Glenside Blvd to Broadway
- Broadway to Maple Grove
- Maple Grove to Woodside (right)
- Woodside back to the Community Center

Signage will be provided.

Council Member Lowe moved to authorize Arc/Muskegon to hold their 5K walk in Roosevelt Park on Saturday, March 28, 2009 and waive the rental fee for use of the Community Center. The motion was supported by Mayor Pro Tem Buikema and carried unanimously.
