City of Roosevelt Park – Building & Construction Fees

Building Permit Rate Table

Building permit fees will be calculated based on the value of the proposed improvements being constructed. The value of the proposed improvements will be established by one of the two following methods:

A copy of the contract from the licensed contractor performing the work is provided showing the cost of the improvements; or

The Building & Zoning Inspector will calculate the value of the proposed improvements using the Square Foot Construction Cost Table as published by the *Building Safety Journal* and/or the schedule outlined in the sections below.

\$1 - \$1000	\$40.00
\$1001 - \$5000	\$40.00 + \$2.25 / \$100 over \$1,000
\$5001 - \$10,000	\$40.00 + \$2.75 / \$100 over \$1,000
\$10,000 - \$250,000	\$315 + \$5.50 / \$1,000 over \$10,000
\$250,000- \$2,000,000	\$1,650 + \$9.00 / \$1,000 over \$250,000
Over \$2,000,000	\$17,400 + \$5.00 / \$1,000 over \$2,000,000

Miscellaneous Construction Activity - Fees

- **Swimming Pools** – Determined by permit fee schedule.
- **Signs** – Construction/installation - Determined by the regular permit fee schedule.
- **Sheds**
 - o Under 200 square feet - \$25.00 development permit.
 - o Over 200 square feet - Determined by the regular permit fee schedule.
- **Fences** - \$25.00.
- **Demolition** - \$100.00.
- **Relocating a structure** – Determined by the regular permit fee schedule.
- **Miscellaneous/additional Inspections** – An additional fee of \$40.00 may be assessed when determined necessary by the Building & Zoning Inspector due to unanticipated or additional re-inspections.

Plan Review Fee

Residential (1 & 2 Family)

Under \$20,000 improvement	\$25.00
Over \$20,000 improvement	\$50.00

For buildings with an estimated construction value up to \$3,000,000, the Building Plan Review fee is 0.0029 of the estimated value (\$250 minimum). For buildings with an estimated construction value over \$3,000,000 up to \$6,000,000, the fee is \$8,700 plus 0.0006 of the estimated value over \$3,000,000. For buildings over \$6,000,000, the fee is \$10,500 plus 0.0005 of the valuation over \$6,000,000.

The plan review fee for Electrical, Mechanical, Plumbing, Fire, Accessibility, and Energy Reviews is computed at 20 percent of the Building Plan Review fee for each discipline (\$250 minimum).

The Sprinkler Review fee is based on the number of sprinkler heads: 1-100, \$275; 101-200, \$325; 201-300, \$350; 301- 400, \$375; 401-500, \$425; over 500, \$500 plus \$0.33 per sprinkler over 500. For hydraulically designed systems, multiply the fee by 2.
